Might I suggest resolving to actually increase/start using our programs to save some money? It won't make your butt look smaller, but it will make you look better to your taxpayers and bosses. Unlike Jenny Craig, Weightwatchers, and others, you don't have to pay to join our programs. If you want some before and after photos of satisfied customers who saved money, just give me a buzz. (Savings results are typical of active customers not relying on professional trainer).

Seriously now, we are all in the same predicament regarding tax revenues and budgets. I don't know how many people/organizations have been offering to help you save money, but I'll bet it is not many. I would much rather increase my Bureau's revenue by helping you save more than to see our programs cut. So, again, let us help you.

Speaking of saving money. In just the last two weeks, I have personally fielded three calls from organizations seeking NEW back-up power generators (Mont Alto Fire Company, Marion Volunteer Fire Department, and Franklin Park Ambulance Project). Looks like some federal or state funding is getting around and these organizations are thinking about back-up power. WE CAN HELP! I have been screening military surplus at the Letterkenny Army Depot and there are a lot of 10, 15, 30, and 60 kW generators available. Note that most are diesel or multi-fuel (kerosene, jet fuel, diesel). Of course our surcharge for these units is just pennies on the dollar. However, as I recently found out some folks just gotta have new or gotta have natural gas/liquid propane. WE CAN HELP! For counterdrug suitable applications, we can get you GSA pricing on BRAND NEW Kohler, Onan, Cummings, Caterpillar, Baldor, and other brand name generators. What's that? You say you need transfer switches, regulators, relays, an extended warranty, transformers, or battery storage? You guessed it- WE CAN HELP! Franklin Park Ambulance is buying a new Cummins/Onan 50 kW diesel with a base sticker price of under \$12k. With those low prices, you can afford to throw on the goodies like enclosure, alarms, digital displays, and more. If you are in the market, please give Al Dean, Scott Pepperman, or myself a call or drop us a line.

Check out Scott Pepperman's column for our 2009 Hermitage warehouse opening calendar. Speaking of calendars, Joe Angelo has just put the finishing touches on the 2009 PennDOT surplus equipment auction calendar. Sorry, only two sales this year. With the budget as it is, looks like we will be hanging on to what we got for a while longer. With just two sales, you definitely won't want to miss either.

Be advised that we have crossed a significant boundary with our Historic Bridge project. We have developed a new and unique sales contract that encompasses the requirements for upkeep to historic preservation standards. North York Borough has signed this agreement for the Marsh Creek Bridge. In addition, PennDOT has recently completed the bid for the replacement bridge. Kinsley Construction of York won the bid and has already voiced their support to assisting with the relocation project.

Our Bureau also has bids on the street for electronic device recycling (e-cycling) and for auctioneer service. Actions taken during evaluation are confidential, so at this time, all we can tell you is to stand by for an update once the awards are made.

Finally, I know I have mentioned this before, but please do take a moment to check out our new Fixed Price Vehicle website. Stu (Stuart Mosebey - our financial and IT genius) swears up and down it will be completed and ready for use on Friday, 1/9/09. Sorry for the false starts. We really have been getting some exceptional vehicle values of late, and this website will show just who got what and at what ridiculously low price. ITEMS RECENTLY ACQUIRED BY YOUR NEIGHBORS!

- **CITY OF SCRANTON (LACKAWANNA COUNTY)** recently acquired 2 travel trailers from the Federal Surplus Property Program which will be used as command posts for law enforcement in events such as the Scranton Annual St Patrick's Day Parade always attended by local, state, national and international dignitaries. This **Parade generates substantial revenue for the City each year and security is very important.** These trailers originally cost the Federal government a total of \$37,629.28 but the city was able to acquire them for a total service and handling charge of just \$3,700.00. City officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$20,000.
- **EXETER TOWNSHIP (BERKS COUNTY)** just received a travel trailer through the Program which will be used as a mobile command center for **Homeland security.** The Federal government originally paid \$18,814.64 for this trailer however the Township was able to acquire it for a service and handling charge of only \$1,850.00. Township officials estimate a cost savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$18,000.
- **JACKSON TOWNSHIP (SNYDER COUNTY)** recently acquired a travel trailer through the Program which will be used for emergency use by first responders for **Homeland security.** The Federal government originally paid \$18,814.64 for this trailer but the Township was able to acquire it for a service and handling charge of just \$1,850.00. Township officials estimate a cost savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$9,000.
- **THROOP BOROUGH (LACKAWANNA COUNTY)** just received a travel trailer through our Program which will be used as a work office for the municipality saving them additional tax dollars. The Federal government originally paid \$18,814.64 for this trailer but the Borough was able to acquire one for a service and handling charge of just \$1,850.00. Borough officials estimate a cost savings to their tax payers of approximately \$16,900 in additional to future savings due to the ability to use this space as an office.
- **WHITEMARSH TOWNSHIP (MONTGOMERY COUNTY)** recently acquired 2 travel trailers through the Program which will be used as both temporary offices and temporary shelters in case of emergency. The Federal government originally paid a total of \$37,629.28 for these trailers but the Township was able to acquire them for a service and handling charge total of only \$3,700.00. Township officials estimate a total cost savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$30,000.
- **MILLERSVILLE UNIVERSITY (LANCASTER COUNTY)** just received 2 milling machines through the Program which will be used in the metal manufacturing lab at Millersville University. They are used by Industrial Technology and Technology Educations majors in their coursework, **creating new jobs for the future.** The Federal government originally paid a total of \$16,000.00 for these milling machines but the University was able to acquire them for a total service and handling charge of just \$675.00. University officials estimate a cost savings to their students and the tax payers of the State System of Higher Education of approximately \$30,000.
- **NEWPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT (PERRY COUNTY)** recently acquired 2 rabbit cage racks from the Program which will be used their new animal science laboratory. The Federal government originally paid \$4,000.00 for these racks but the School was able to acquire these racks for a total service and handling charge of only \$300.00. School officials estimate a savings to their students and taxpayers of approximately \$2,000.00.
- **BUFFALO TOWNSHIP (UNION COUNTY)** just received a generator through the Program which will be used as **back up power** for the Township Building. The Federal government originally paid a total of \$10,000.00 for this generator, but the Township was able to acquire it for a total service and handling charge of just \$4,995.00. Township officials estimate a cost savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$7,000.00.
