From The Director's Chair

Ammo Update We have received inquiries from several dozen local enforcement agencies expressing an interest in U.S. Govt. contract pricing for ammunition. Thank you all. Scott Pepperman has compiled a spreadsheet summarizing the needs and will be sending it the Joint Munitions Command (JMC) at the Rock Island Arsenal tomorrow. So, we should have pricing and lead time information very soon. We did receive a list of DOD codes for munitions which list the minimum package quantities. For example, 12 ga #00 buckshot cartridges are packed 320 to a carton. 9 mm, 147 grain, hollow point cartridges are boxed in multiples of 2000. .300 Winchester magnum match grade cartridges will only be available in cases of 480. At this time, we have hit our first speed bump. The armory indicates that they will NOT accept purchase orders or payment from the local law enforcement agencies. This means that the Bureau of Supplies and Surplus will have to order and **pay in advance** for all ammunition. We have met with representatives of Procurement and Central Services Comptrollers' Operations. We are hopeful of establishing a "pass through purchasing fund" to permit us to accept payment from local agencies; hold it (like escrow); purchase and pay using state documents and funds; and have the ammo drop shipped to the local agency. More to follow as the situation unfolds. As you might imagine, it takes some effort to coordinate this type of process between Federal, State, and local governments. THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE.

New Weapons Case Study I recently worked on a quote for the Vernon Township Police Department for new automatic weapons. The process was new, and both Chief Detzel and I learned a great deal. So, here is your opportunity to learn at someone else's expense. The Chief indicated that he was interested in 4 automatic weapons. We discussed what was available (M16A2, M16A4, M4, M4A1). We settled on the M4 carbine. It's short barrel and stock, large 30 round magazine, and 3 round burst capability seemed appropriate for urban special operations (very counterdrug suitable). I received the Chief's request on Friday, Nov 2. I sent him the quote the same day I received it from the arsenal, Wednesday, Nov 21. **(Lesson 1 – allow 3 to 4 weeks for quotes)** For four brand new M4 carbines, made by Colt Industries, the price was \$1375.32 per weapon. This includes our 4% service fee, but does not include delivery. The weapons carry a one year manufacturer's warranty. The price includes a combat sling, one 30 round magazine, a blank firing attachment, a rifle cover, a magazine cover, a muzzle cap, and an operator's manual. The specific configuration under contract is for the M4 without handles and hand guards, but with BUIS (back up iron sights) and the popular ARS (adapter rail system). The contract is for NSN (national stock number) 1005-01-231-0973, Colt Defense part number 9390000, model R0979. I wish to emphasize that these are military spec weapons-not modified police models. **(Lesson 2 – although there is little flexibility in configuration, you get a lot for your money)**. When discussing terms, we found that payment is required in advance (see info above regarding "pass through purchasing fund"). On the topic of lead time, we were told that due to current operations in multiple theaters (fighting two wars), if we were to place an order on 11/2/07, the weapons would be delivered in September of 2008. **(Lesson 3 – order early)**. As a reminder, there is no restricted use period like Federal Surplus. Once purchased, these

weapons are yours with no periodic inventory/return requirements. Following is a little more information the M4. Please contact me, Alfred Dean, or Scott Pepperman should you desire to get a quote or purchase on an M16, M4, M9 or M11 pistol, or repair parts/magazines for these weapons.

Equipment Recently Acquired by Your Neighbors...

Pond Hill-Lily Lake Volunteer Fire Company (Luzerne County) recently acquired a tire mount from the Federal Surplus Property Program which will be used for changing all of the tires on their fire trucks. The Federal government originally paid \$6,082.00 for this tire mount, but the Fire Company was able to acquire it for a service and handling fee of just \$81.25. Department officials estimate a cost savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$3,000.00.

Blue Mountain Academy (Berks County) just received 24 computer monitors from the Program which will be used to replace monitors in their computer lab at the school. The Federal government originally paid \$32,400.00 for the monitors but the School was able to acquire them for a service and handling fee of just \$840.00! School officials estimate a savings to their students and families of approximately \$4,000.00.

Pottsville City Housing Authority (Schuylkill County) recently acquired a Zamboni Ice Machine which will be used to maintain the ice skating rink that is operated and maintained by the Housing Authority. The Federal government originally acquired this item for \$62,970.00 but the Housing Authority was able to acquire the Zamboni for a service and handling fee of only \$950.00. Authority officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers and residents of approximately \$2,000.00.

Luzerne County Community College (Luzerne County) just received a Sunnen 6500 valve grinding machine for use as an education tool. The grinder will be placed into their Automotive/Motor sports Department to teach students the proper techniques necessary to grind intake and exhaust valves while rebuilding cylinder heads for both street vehicles and high performance race engines. Because their programs are very hands-on intensive, this equipment provides the student with real world experience in both the automotive and motor sports industries.

As a Department with a limited budget, they depend on equipment and product purchases through the Federal Surplus Property Program. Without this Program, there would be no funds available to make a similar purchase through the bidding process. The Federal government originally paid \$8,294.48 for this grinder, but the College was able to acquire for a service and handling fee of just \$550.00. College officials estimate a savings to their students and taxpayers of approximately \$8,000.00.

Tamaqua Area Little League Baseball Association (Schuylkill County) recently acquired a travel trailer through the Program which will be used for a portable office for registration and tournament games. It will also be used for Committee meetings and as a changing room for the umpires. This item originally cost the Federal government \$17,954.83, but the Baseball Association acquired the trailer for a service and handling fee of just \$4,500. Baseball officials estimate a cost savings to their organization of approximately \$12,000.00.

Clarksville Volunteer Fire Department (Mercer County) just received two Dell laptop computers through the Program which will be used for the local Emergency Management Agency Coordinator for emergency operations, planning, etc and also the Fire Chief for reports or placed in the fire engine with down loaded information. The Federal government originally paid \$4,566.00 but the Fire Department acquired the laptops for a service and handling fee of just \$195.00. Department officials stated that the surplus programs are a great asset to them for obtaining equipment they would not be able to get otherwise and in this case to save the taxpayers approximately \$4,000.00.
