

If your organization has received weapons through the Federal Surplus Property Program you will note that in the near future you will be receiving a letter from Ms. Lil Davis. The letter will ask you to verify in writing that you still have the weapons in your inventory. This is a procedure that we are continuing so that we can meet a requirement from the Federal government. In the future we will also be conducting random physical visits to verify retention of weapons. If you desire to no longer keep and use the weapons you may have received, you must contact Ms. Davis first at 717-525-5803, or by email at [ldavis@state.pa.us](mailto:ldavis@state.pa.us) We thank you for your anticipated cooperation.

## Items recently acquired by your neighbors

**Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare, Wernersville State Hospital (Berks County)** recently acquired a bucket truck through the Federal Surplus Property Program which will be used for maintenance on approximately 30 buildings and hundreds of trees. The truck originally cost the Federal government \$90,000.00 but the Department was able to acquire it from the Program for a service and handling fee of just \$28,500.00. Department officials estimate a savings to the Commonwealth taxpayers of approximately \$60,000.00.

**The Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare, Danville State Hospital (Montour County)** just received 12 rotary chairs from the Program which will be used to replace office chairs throughout their facility. The chairs originally cost the Federal government \$6,091.20 but the Department was able to acquire them for a service charge of only \$330.00. Department officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$900.00.

**East Mead Township (Crawford County)** recently acquired a travel trailer from the Program which will be used for the storage of Township records. The Federal government originally paid \$20,000.00 for this trailer, but the Township was able to acquire it for a service and handling charge of just \$4,500.00. Township officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$15,000.00.

**Pottstown Healthcare Corporation (Montgomery County)** just acquired 2 dental delivery system chairs from the Program which will be used at their new dental clinic that opened in May 2008. The Federal government originally paid a total cost of \$15,670.00, but the Corporation was able to acquire the dental chairs for a service and handling charge of just \$750.00. Corporation officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$3,000.00.

**Luzerne County Community College (Luzerne County)** recently acquired 3 tables from the Program which will be used in their automobile technology class for engine assembly benches. The Federal government originally paid \$4,500.00 for these tables, but the College was able to acquire them for a service and handling charge of just \$225.00. College officials estimate a savings to their students of approximately \$650.00.

## Did You Know What Your Neighbors Just Acquired?

Spring Township Police Department (Berks County) recently acquired 12 sets of binoculars which will be placed in all marked patrol vehicles for general law enforcement use. The Federal government originally paid \$324.00 each for the binoculars, but the Township Police Department only paid \$240.00 for the total of all 12 binoculars. Department officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$3,700.00.

Cumberland County Prison (Cumberland County) just acquired a storage cabinet through the Law Enforcement Property Program which will be used for tool storage for the institution's use. The Federal government originally paid \$1183.00 for the storage cabinet, but the Prison was able to acquire this item for a service and handling charge of just \$235.00. Prison officials estimate a savings to County taxpayers of approximately \$1,000.00.

### Items Recently Acquired by Your Neighbors

Hatfield Township (Montgomery County) recently acquired a 2008 Chevy Tahoe through the 1122 Program which will be used for all law enforcement activity that is a result of counter-drug activity, about 80% of all crime. By utilizing the Pennsylvania 1122 Program, Department officials estimate a savings of approximately \$11,000.00 for their taxpayers. The total cost to the Department for this vehicle was approximately \$25,000.00
