Sometime after the first of the year, we will be setting up the shelving and likely changing the layout of the store to be more customer-friendly. ## FEMA Trailer Update

For almost one year, the Pennsylvania State Agency has been working with FEMA to receive travel trailers and mobile homes for the Commonwealth that are excess to FEMA's needs. Finally, we are seeing the fruits of our labor as FEMA is preparing to declare almost 10,000 trailers and mobile homes excess to their needs. Currently, the bulk of the trailers and mobile homes are located in Hope, Arkansas, but many may be even closer to Pennsylvania. In order to keep service charges as low as possible, we will attempt to locate the closer trailers first.

## Equipment Recently Acquired by Your Neighbors...

**Centre Township (Berks County)**, acquired a commercial paint shaker which will be used to mix paint for road maintenance and line painting. The shaker, originally valued at \$4,546.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$300.00. Township officials estimate a savings of approximately \$2,000.00.

**Pennsylvania Department of Corrections, (Cumberland County)**, acquired 55 chairs which will be used to replace older chairs among the staff of the Correctional facilities. The chairs, originally valued at \$16,000.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$550.00. Department officials estimate a savings to Commonwealth taxpayers of approximately \$2,000.00.

**Lancaster County Career and Technology Center (Lancaster County)** acquired 6 engine lathes which will be used to upgrade their shops still operating with 1965 model engine lathes. The lathes, originally valued at \$51,500.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$3,000.00. Center officials estimate a savings to their institution of approximately \$45,000.

**Wayside Christian School (Berks County)** acquired 10 Pentium III laptop computers which will be used by the School for their classrooms and students. These computers, originally valued at \$24,813.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$1,000.00. School officials estimate a savings of approximately \$4,000.00 for their students and families.

**Menallen Township (Adams County)** acquired a drill breaker which will be used to break up concrete and maintain their infrastructure. The drill breaker, originally valued at \$6,247.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$325.00. Township officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$3,000.00.

**Pennsylvania Department of Corrections, (Cumberland County)** acquired a bituminous heating kettle which will be used for tarring cracks in their pavement and patching for access roads. The kettle, originally valued at \$19,884.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$400.00. Department officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$4,000.00.

**Keystone Blind Association (Mercer County)**, acquired several items for their organization including a front mount lawn mower and 9 computers. The mower will be used for cutting grass around Commonwealth rest stops and also their own facility; the computers will be used in their headquarters. The items, originally valued at \$14,767.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$1,575.00. Organization officials estimate a savings of approximately \$4,000.00 for the mower and \$4,500.00 for the computers.

**Bethesda Children's Home (Crawford County)**, acquired 6 washer/dryer units which will be used in their cottages that house their children. These new units, originally valued at \$4,752.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$1,800.00. Home officials estimate a savings to their clients of approximately \$3,600.00.

# 1122 New Property

## **Waiver Process Reviewed with the Federal Government**

Recently, we were informed that a waiver process may be available to the Pennsylvania 1122 Program for items that are on GSA Contracts, but not available to 1122 participants. In discussions with both the Executive Director of the 1122 Program and GSA, it appears that no such process is currently in place, but it is a possibility in the future. To that end, Pennsylvania's 1122 Program is pushing for a 1122 National Steering Committee meeting with the Executive Director of the 1122 Program, representatives from the Department of Defense, representatives from GSA, and representatives from the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to discuss a possible waiver process. Pennsylvania has participated on the Steering Committee several times in the past. We would like to schedule the meeting before the end of the current calendar year quarter in March 2007. We will keep you posted!

## **Visit to the Warfighters!**

We visited DLA in Philadelphia recently to meet with representatives of their Warfighter Catalogue, which features clothing and clothing accessories, in order to determine whether or not their products would be suitable and available for Pennsylvania Law Enforcement agencies.
