## From The Director's Chair

As mentioned in last month's Sampler, we conducted physical inventories of both the Hermitage & Harrisburg Federal Surplus Property warehouses. I am happy to report that once again, accuracy was outstanding. Scott and his team found 99.155% of what they were supposed to have. I cannot thank the folks in Federal Surplus enough for exercising the kind of discipline necessary to insure that we are able to satisfy our customers. Next year, however, we plan to set the bar a little bit higher by changing the formula for determining accuracy. Can't let 'em rest on their laurels.

The results are in for the public portion of the Nazareth online sale of surplus Penndot heavy equipment. While it was not a record in terms of overall revenue, I have noted that number of bidders is really starting to climb. This sale saw 356 active bidders. Our prior best for an online heavy equipment sale was 236 at Nazareth last year. That is a gain of 35.9%. This information tells me that the marketing we have been employing for our sales has been effective. The high number of repeat buyers also tells me that buyers continue to find value at these sales. You might also have noted that this year, employees of our Bureau have been performing the title work in order to save money and increase quality. We had to lean on Penndot and the DGS-Bureau of Motor Vehicle team for assistance at the really big sales. We hope that you have noticed the difference having all the transactions handled internally.

Head's up – Penndot will be implementing a new business system next summer. This MAY require 2 large sales instead of the 3-5 we have been holding. If so, then you might want to start thinking about setting aside your equipment funds earlier than usual. It is possible that the first municipal sale may be as early as March. As soon as the calendar is finalized, we will notify you via this document, post it on our website, and post it on Asset-Auctions website.

Last summer at the Punxsutawney First Responders' seminar, several of you told me that you were in the market for a John Deere gator. Apparently many of you had swamp land or water's edge patrol and rescue operations that you needed a special vehicle for. Well, we just received a really capable vehicle in Federal Surplus that is just what you are looking for. It is a Supercat 6 x 6 ATV. It is posted on our inventory as FSC number 2320-06-0735-002. ## FEMA Trailers Declared Excess!

For almost one year, the Pennsylvania State Agency has been working with FEMA to receive travel trailers and mobile homes for the Commonwealth that are excess to FEMA's needs. Finally, we are seeing the fruits of our labor as FEMA is preparing to declare almost 10,000 trailers and mobile homes excess to their needs. As soon as we can receive descriptions and pictures, we will forward the information to you. Currently, the bulk of the trailers and mobile homes are located in Hope, Arkansas, but many may be even closer to Pennsylvania. In order to keep service charges as low as possible, we will attempt to locate the closer trailers first. ## Flood Relief Update

Since late June 2006 when flooding hit the eastern part of Pennsylvania, the Federal Surplus Property Program has worked with local communities to provide relief in the form of excess Federal government property. **Cen-Clear Child Services, Inc.** (Clearfield County) acquired 303 utility shirts that will be used for their maintenance department. The shirts, originally valued at \$4,599.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$757.00. Organization officials estimate a cost savings to their clients of approximately \$6,800.00.

**The City of Harrisburg** (Dauphin County) acquired a Still forklift with a capacity of 6000 lbs that will be used for their incinerators and steam generation facility. The forklift, originally valued at \$15,009.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$5,000.00. City officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$15,000.00.

**Ferndale Borough** (Cambria County) acquired a 1998 John Deere 6 x 4 utility vehicle, commonly known as a “gator”, that will be used for cutting grass, used by the police department to access narrow areas in the Borough, and used by the Fire Department for security during the Borough’s Jubilee. The “gator”, originally valued at \$13,541.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$3,500.00. Borough officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$10,000.00.

**Lebanon County Commissioners** (Lebanon County) acquired a Hobart EL3 mini-pulper which will be used to pulp garbage for disposal, allowing it to fit into the proper disposal cans. The pulper, originally valued at \$18,447.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$750.00. County officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$3,750.00.

**Lancaster County Career and Technology Center** (Lancaster County) acquired 13 flat screen computer monitors which will be used in their instructor’s offices. The monitors, originally valued at \$4,550.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$585.00. The Center officials estimate a savings to their students and taxpayers of approximately \$2,000.00.

**Pennsylvania Game Commission** (Dauphin County) acquired 40 Tungsten hand held Palm Pilots which will be used for their field agents to keep their notes. These Palm Pilots, originally valued at \$19,960.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$2,000.00. Game Commission officials estimate a savings to the Commonwealth taxpayers of approximately \$19,000.00 with this acquisition.

**Western Wayne School District** (Wayne County) acquired 81 computer tables which will be used to replace older tables throughout the School District’s computer labs. These tables, originally valued at \$9,639.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$1,215.00. School officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$8,000.00.

**Solanco School District** (Lancaster County) acquired 38 computer tables for use in their middle school computer lab. The tables, originally valued at \$4,522.00 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$570.00. School District officials estimate a cost savings of approximately \$2,500.00 for their taxpayers.

**Jefferson Hills Volunteer Fire Company** (Allegheny County) acquired a centrifuge pump unit that will be used for a truck currently being used by the Department. The pump unit, originally valued at \$5,545.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$100.00. Fire Company officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$4,000.00 with this acquisition.

**Newville Borough** (Cumberland County) acquired a diesel generator set that will be used to power a water treatment plant and a waste water treatment plant. The generator set, originally valued at \$32,497.00 by the Federal government, was acquired for a service charge of only \$3,750.00. Borough officials estimate a savings to their taxpayers of approximately \$37,000.00.

**Pennsylvania Department of Corrections**, SCI Retreat (Luzerne County) acquired 9 shelters which will be used to store targets for Correctional Officer training. The shelters, originally valued at \$126,000 by the Federal government, were acquired for a service charge of only \$2,700.00. Department officials estimate a savings to the taxpayers of approximately \$2,000.00.

**Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture** (Dauphin County) acquired a 500 Series fifth-wheeled mobile unit that will be used by the Department for a veterinary laboratory in case of any disease outbreak among animals in the Commonwealth, with the ability to save countless lives as well as to help prevent any outbreak among humans. It will also be used to eliminate diseases in some areas of the Commonwealth among our animal population. The total cost to the Department of Agriculture was \$541,952.00, delivered. Department officials estimate a savings to Commonwealth taxpayers by using the 1122 Program of approximately \$35,000.00.
