Armstrong County Housing Authority	Provides funds for the capital and management activities of Public Housing Agencies as authorized under Section 9 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437g) (the "Act"), including modernization and development of public housing. The funds cannot be used for operations or rental assistance.	\$ 916,156
Crooked Creek Lake	Award and completed contract to provide enhanced cleaning, grounds keeping and maintenance services for recreation areas	\$ 78,000
Crooked Creek Lake	Hire 2 temporary summer park rangers for water and public safety patrols. Will reduce public water related fatalities and accidents	\$ 33,000
Crooked Creek Lake	Hire one seasonal 10-month park ranger to develop partnerships/programming in reducing public waer-related fatalities. Ranger will support Crooked creek and Mahoning Lakes	\$ 50,000
Crooked Creek Lake	Control Tower repairs (heating system, grating, covers, concrete). Award and complete contract and improve conditions and safety for employees.	\$ 100,000
Crooked Creek Lake	Services for increased shoreline management, threatened/endangered species surveillance, cultural resource protection/preservation, invasive species eradication, and protection of natural resoucrs.	\$ 15,000
North Side Industrial Development C.	This award provides funding for clean up of hazardous substance contaminants and will encourage redevelopment of the site such that the future reuse of the property will create/retain jobs and does not pose a threat to human health and the environment.	\$ 300,000
