## Direct Benefits to Families

How PA Benefits	People Helped in Beaver County	Explanation of Benefits
Food Assistance	22,157	Hungry children and adults will receive more help through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Food Stamps)
Health Insurance	29,888	Low income children and adults will continue to have access to health care through Medical Assistance
Health Insurance for Unemployed	8,100	Unemployed persons who could qualify for more help purchasing health insurance as of September 2009
Tax Relief	74,479	Taxpaying individuals and households - all but high earners qualify for taxpayer relief
Unemployment Compensation	7,100	Jobless adults who received a boost in Unemployment Compensation from February to October 2009
