Food Assistance	7,683	Hungry children and adults will receive more help through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Food Stamps)
Health Insurance	12,041	Low income children and adults will continue to have access to health care through Medical Assistance
Health Insurance for Unemployed	2,500	Unemployed persons who could qualify for more help purchasing health insurance as of September 2009
Tax Relief	26,019	Taxpaying individuals and households - all but high earners qualify for taxpayer relief
Unemployment Compensation	1,900	Jobless adults who received a boost in Unemployment Compensation from February to October 2009
