NEW TOLL-FREE NUMBER, ONLINE FORM AVAILABLE TO REPORT UNSAFE DRIVING, IMPROPER STATE VEHICLE USE

HARRISBURG – The public now has two new ways of reporting when state vehicles are driven unsafely or used improperly.

The Department of General Services today launched a new, toll-free number and online form that will make it easier for the public to report these issues.

The toll-free number to report unsafe driving by state vehicles is 1-877-347-9966. The online form to report unsafe driving can be found at www.dgs.state.pa.us by clicking on the link in the left column, “Report Unsafe Driving, Improper Use, of a State Vehicle.”

Those reporting an incident should offer as many specifics as possible, such as the nature of the unsafe driving behavior and the state vehicle’s license plate number, color, make and model of the state vehicle. Details on the time and location will also be helpful in investigating the incident.
