Route 3037 Bridge Project Completed in Wayne County

Project funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

DUNMORE– PennDOT Engineering District 4 today announced that an \$800,000 bridge improvement project in Wayne County has been completed. The project is financed by federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

Grace Industries of Bath, Northampton County, rehabilitated a bridge over Middle Creek on Route 3037 (Cadwalder Road) in the borough of Hoadleys/Cherry Ridge Township, Wayne County. Work began in late August and included the design and replacement of the superstructure and includes approach roadway work.

Within the six-county region of northeastern Pennsylvania, PennDOT will invest \$72 million of federal economic recovery funds on 17 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and curb ramp replacements.
