ECONOMIC RECOVERY CONTRACT AWARDED FOR TWO LORETTO ROAD BRIDGES

Project Funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

LORETTO ROAD – PennDOT District 9 today announced the award of a contract for another economic recovery project in south central Pennsylvania that is funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

PennDOT awarded Cottle's Asphalt Maintenance, Inc. of Everett an \$878,253 contract for a design/build project to rehabilitate two structures on Route 1001 (Manor Drive) over the RJ Corman Railroad in Allegheny Township, Cambria County.

Design of the project is expected to begin this summer, with construction scheduled for later this year or in spring 2010. The work will consist of removing the existing bituminous overlay and replacing it with a latex overlay, resealing joints and making substructure repairs.

Within District 9, PennDOT will invest approximately \$47 million of federal economic recovery funds on 17 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and signal upgrades.
