Governor Rendell to Mark Recovery Act's First Anniversary at Cumberland County Bridge

Harrisburg – Governor Edward G. Rendell will mark the first anniversary of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act by officially opening the Route 34 bridge near Carlisle at 1:30 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 17. The new bridge, which replaced a span built in 1930, was financed by the Recovery Act.
