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PENNDOT AWARDS ECONOMIC RECOVERY CONTRACT TO IMPROVE PA 924 AND PA 61 IN SCHUYLKILL COUNTY

ALLENTOWN – PennDOT Engineering District 5 today announced the award of a contract to improve PA 924 in Frackville Borough and West Mahanoy Township, Schuylkill County. The contract will also improve PA 61 in Frackville Borough. The contract is financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

PennDOT awarded Pennsy Supply, Inc. of Hummelstown, Dauphin County the \$719,892 contract to improve PA 924 between PA 61 and the Gilberton Borough line, and PA 61 between the West Mahanoy Township line and PA 924.

The project calls for milling and paving, curb ramp upgrades, and guiderail upgrades.

This is a design-build project. Design-build is a project delivery system where the design and construction aspects are contracted with a single entity, in this case Pennsy Supply, Inc. Construction is expected to begin at some point over the next several months.

Within the six-county District 5 region, PennDOT will invest \$122 million of federal economic recovery funds on 23 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and Intelligent Transportation System installations.
