State Route 666 Resurfacing Project Awarded in Forest County

Oil City – PennDOT awarded a \$213, 369 contract to IA Construction Corporation of Franklin, Venango County, to resurfacing a section of State Route (SR) 666 in Kingsley Township, Forest County. This project is being funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

The project limits begin west of the intersection with SR 4010 Creek Road and extend east to Little Minister Creek. The project is expected to begin the first week of May and is expected to be completed by the middle of June.

This project is one of 35 ARRA-funded projects in PennDOT's six-county District 1 region which consists of Crawford, Erie, Forest, Mercer, Venango and Warren counties.
