**SNYDER & UNION COUNTY TRANSPORTATION STIMULUS  
PROJECT SET TO START JUNE 15**  
**Contract Funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act**

**MONTOURSVILLE** – Prime contractor Eastern Industries, Inc. from Winfield, Union County will start roadway rehabilitation work on Route 235 in Snyder and Union counties beginning June 15. The \$1.9 million project is funded with stimulus dollars from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

The work will cover a 9.5-mile stretch of Route 235 from Troxelville in Snyder County, north to Route 45 (just north of Laurelton) in Union County.

There is also a 10' vehicle width restriction that will be implemented for both northbound and southbound traffic for the duration of this project.

The work will include numerous roadway base repairs, drainage pipe replacements, guide rail upgrades, an epoxy-based surface treatment for the Glen Iron Bridge over Penns Creek, paving and other related items.

The project is scheduled to be complete by October 23.

Within the nine-county north central region, PennDOT will invest \$45 million of federal economic recovery funds on transportation projects that range from resurfacings and bridge replacements to guide rail and traffic sign upgrades.
