## **CRAWFORD COUNTY RESURFACING PROJECT AWARDED**

*Resurfacing Project Funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act*

**OIL CITY** – PennDOT announced today that resurfacing project on SR 77 (Hickory Street) in Crawford County has been awarded. This project is being funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)

A \$2,213,188 contract for this project was awarded to Russell Standard Corporation of Union City, Erie County.

This resurfacing project is one of 28 ARRA-funded projects in PennDOT's six-county District 1 region which consists of Crawford, Erie, Forest, Mercer, Venango and Warren counties.

This project includes the milling and resurfacing of SR 77 (Hickory Street) in Blooming Valley Borough, West Mead, East Mead, Woodcock, Richmond, Athens and Bloomfield Townships. Work is expected to begin on June 22 and to be completed by early August.
